Reconciliation Guidelines For Holy Guardian Angels Parish

As parishioners prepare for the sacrament of reconciliation this weekend, please review the following guidelines before entering the church –

- 1. Check your temperature before you leave your home. If you have a temperature or are ill, remain at home.
- 2. For Saturday, July 11 Confessions start at 9am. In the future we will offer reservations via SignUpGenius or you may call the Parish office at 708-485-2900 from 9-5pm M-F to make a reservation for Reconciliation.
- 3. A face mask is required to enter the church and must be worn at all times; without a mask you will not be allowed to enter the church.
- 4. You will be asked to wait outside of the Church. If there is inclement weather, a limited number of people will be allowed to wait in the Church. Due to social distancing requirements, no more than 10 individuals are allowed in the Church at any time. If the maximum is reached, you will be asked to wait outside the church.
- 5. Enter through the main entrance only. We appreciate your patience as a greeter will check you in and record your contact information (This is a State of IL requirement, for contact tracing purposes).
- 6. Sanitize your hands, as directed by the greeter.
- 7. Observe proper social distancing at all times; look for the floor markings to guide you.
- 8. If there is inclement weather Greeters / Ushers will direct you where to wait.
- 9. After your confession, exit by the nearest door and do your penance at home.

While our parish staff will attempt to take the appropriate precautions consistent with the advice of public health authorities, parishioners and guests should understand that they assume the risk of contracting COVID-19 any time they enter a public space since such precautions do not eliminate the risk of infection.
